

Ferrari World Abu Dhabi to launch roof walk and zip line attractions



The state-of-the-art attractions are set to include Family Zone which will open in March 2020 and a roof walk and zip line experiences confirmed for later this year. The Family Zone will be an area dedicated to the younger guests to the park, and the rides here have no such restrictions. There will be four state-of-the-art miniature versions namely **Turbo Tower**, **Speedway Race**, **Flying Wings** and a **Formula Rossa Junior**. They will also be introducing a Roof Walk & Zip Line experience to its visitors which means that guests will be able to scale the iconic red roof of the park.

Mangrove Walk on Al Jubail Island in Abu Dhabi opened.

Abu Dhabi's Mangrove Walk - Jubail Mangrove Park, is now open to the public and has boardwalk with three routes and six educational sections, including floating platform.

The 1 million-square-metre area is full with mangroves that spread out on either side of a winding boardwalk. It is open to visitors daily from 8am to 6.30pm.

Birds, fish and crabs are among the wildlife. The water is clear, giving unblocked views of mangrove roots and marine life.



Sharjah's new cultural landmark - House of Wisdom to open in this April



Sharjah will open a state-of-the-art public library, aptly named **House of Wisdom**.

Which is located on the Sharjah International Airport Road, sits amidst landscaped gardens, and already contains *The Scroll* - a visually striking artwork which was unveiled when Sharjah was announced as host city for World Book Capital.

The House of Wisdom will be a two-storey building and home to more than 105,000 books and will blend traditional and digital sources of knowledge. It will be open to the public of all age groups and nationalities.
